

## **Regulations - I International Scientific Conference “Tourism and Recreation in Research and Practice. Traditions and Contemporary Challenges”**

### **§ 1. General Provisions**

1. These Regulations set forth the rules for the organization of and participation in the 1st International Scientific Conference “Tourism and Recreation in Scientific Research and Practice. Traditions and Contemporary Challenges,” hereinafter referred to as the “Conference.”
2. The Conference will be held on June 11–13, 2026, at the facilities of the Bronisław Czech University of Physical Culture in Kraków, Al. Jana Pawła II 78, 31-571 Kraków.
3. The organizer of the Conference is the Bronisław Czech University of Physical Culture in Kraków, hereinafter referred to as the “Organizer.”
4. The Conference is of a scientific nature and is dedicated to issues in the field of research on tourism, recreation, and leisure time, from an interdisciplinary perspective.

### **§ 2. Format of the Conference and Rules of Participation**

1. The Conference shall be held on-site. The languages of the Conference are Polish and English.
2. The Conference Regulations have also been prepared in English. In the event of any discrepancies in interpretation, the Polish-language version shall prevail. Conference participants may include, in particular, researchers, doctoral students, undergraduates, and representatives of industry circles interested in the Conference’s subject matter.
3. The conditions for participation in the Conference are:
  - 1) registration via the registration form available on the Conference website,
  - 2) payment of the conference fee in the amount and by the deadline specified in these Rules and Regulations.
4. Deadlines for registration, abstract submission, and notification of acceptance are published in conference announcements posted on the Conference website <https://conferences-wtir.akf.krakow.pl/>.
5. The conference fee applies to both presenting and non-presenting participants and is the same for both forms of participation.
6. Registration for the Conference via the registration form constitutes acknowledgment of the content of these Regulations and acceptance thereof.

### **§ 3. Conference Fees**

1. Participation in the Conference shall be subject to a fee.
2. The following conference fees apply:
  - 850 PLN – standard fee, covering participation in the proceedings and accompanying events (workshops and expert panels), conference materials, and meals;
  - 650 PLN – reduced fee for doctoral students and undergraduate students, covering participation in the proceedings and accompanying events (workshops and expert panels), conference materials, meals, and participation in the Young Scientists Competition.
3. Participants are responsible for covering their own accommodation and travel expenses to the Conference.
4. Participation in the banquet (gala dinner) is subject to an additional fee and is not included in the basic conference fee; detailed information regarding costs and participation rules will be

provided in a separate organizational announcement, which will be published by May 15, 2026, on the Conference website <https://conferences-wtir.akf.krakow.pl/>.

6. A VAT invoice will be issued within 14 days of the payment being posted and sent according to the details provided in the registration form.

#### **§ 4. Conference publications and certificates**

1. Information regarding post-conference publications, including the scientific monograph and special issues of the journal "Folia Turistica," is specified in separate conference announcements.
2. Certificates of participation in the Conference will be issued in electronic form.

#### **§ 5. Copyright and authors' liability**

1. Conference participants retain the moral and economic rights to the papers, posters, multimedia presentations, and other academic materials they present.
2. Submission of a paper and its presentation during the Conference constitute a declaration by the author that they hold the copyright to the presented content and that these materials do not infringe upon the rights of third parties.
3. The author bears full responsibility for the content presented during the Conference, including its compliance with applicable laws and the principles of academic ethics.
4. The Organizer is not liable for any infringement of copyright or other third-party rights by Conference Participants.
5. Submission of a paper is tantamount to consenting to its presentation during the Conference and to the publication of the paper's abstract in the conference proceedings and on the Conference website.

#### **§ 6. Young Scientists Competition**

1. A Young Scientists Competition is organized as part of the Conference.
2. The rules for participation in the Young Scientists Competition, including evaluation criteria and the procedure for selecting winners, are set forth in a separate Young Scientists Competition Regulations, constituting Appendix 1 to these Regulations.

#### **§ 7. Protection of Personal Data**

1. The rules for processing the personal data of Conference participants are set forth in the GDPR Information Notice, which constitutes Appendix 2 to these Regulations.

#### **§ 8. Image of Participants**

1. The Organizer hereby informs that during the Conference photographs and audiovisual recordings may be taken for documentary, informational, and promotional purposes related to the Organizer's activities and the Conference. The publication of images of Conference Participants, particularly in the form of individual shots or close-ups, is based on the consent voluntarily provided by the Participants in the registration form, subject to applicable laws.

2. The publication of materials depicting the course of the Conference, including group photos and general shots of the event, in which the image of the Participants constitutes a detail of the whole, does not require separate consent, in accordance with applicable laws.

#### **§ 9. Rules of Conduct**

1. Conference Participants are required to comply with the rules of conduct in effect on the premises of the University of Physical Culture in Krakow and to uphold academic decorum and social coexistence.
2. Participants may not disrupt the course of the Conference or engage in activities contrary to the law, principles of good conduct, or the interests of the Organizer and third parties.
3. The Organizer has the right to exclude from participation any persons violating the above rules.
4. The Organizer is not liable for personal belongings left unattended on the Conference premises.

#### **§ 10. Withdrawal from participation in the Conference**

1. Withdrawal from participation in the Conference must be made in writing and should be sent electronically to the Organizer's email address indicated on the Conference website.
2. In the event of a withdrawal notified by April 30, 2026, the Organizer will refund the conference fee paid.
3. In the event of a withdrawal notified after April 30, 2026, the conference fee is non-refundable.
4. Failure to attend the Conference without prior notification of cancellation does not constitute grounds for a refund of the conference fee.

#### **§ 11. Final Provisions**

1. The Organizer reserves the right to change the date and/or format of the Conference in the event that holding it in the specified format or on the specified date becomes impossible or excessively difficult for reasons beyond the Organizer's control.
2. In matters not covered by these Rules, decisions shall be made by the Organizer, in accordance with applicable law.
3. All disputes shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the court having jurisdiction over the registered office of the University.
4. These Rules shall enter into force on the date of their publication on the Conference website.
